Le château de Chambord

EXERCICE 1 : Traduire LE TEXTE EN FRANÇAIS.

The Château de Chambord, located in the Loire Valley, is one of the most famous monuments of the French Renaissance. Built from 1519 under the reign of Francis I, it was designed as a symbol of royal power and architectural innovation, notably thanks to its famous double spiral staircase, probably inspired by Leonardo da Vinci. With more than 400 rooms and 282 fireplaces, Chambord is the largest château in the Loire Valley. Now a UNESCO World Heritage Site, it attracts more than a million visitors each year. This site embodies both the history of the French monarchy and a cultural richness that makes it a major tourist destination in France.
